# 2014 Summer PAID Fellowship with ILR Institute for Compensation Studies in NYC

The Institute for Compensation Studies (ICS) is an interdisciplinary center within the ILR School, with offices in Ithaca and New York City. ICS researches, teaches, and communicates about monetary and non-monetary rewards from work, and how these rewards influence outcomes for individuals, companies, industries, and economies.

ICS is providing one research fellowship for summer 2014 in New York City. As a member of the ICS team, the chosen Fellow will conduct research and assist ICS faculty and staff. This is a paid, full-time fellowship in NYC and will last eight (8) weeks from June through August.

This fellowship is in NYC and pays up to \$3,200 for June 2 – August 1.

### **Performance Pay: Interdisciplinary Perspectives**

The Summer Fellow will focus on the complex topic of performance pay through an interdisciplinary lens. The Fellow will learn about a broad spectrum of pay-for-performance considerations, such as unique characteristics of executive and superstar pay, or how the efficacy and return of a performance-based pay system can be assessed.

The Fellow will gain a wide exposure to academic and business research on pay-for-performance issues while supporting curriculum development for a new Advanced Certificate in Performance Pay, Metrics and Practice Alignment offered by the Institute for Compensation Studies. Experience will also be gained in launching a new product into the marketplace of professional development training.

- Experience with web-based research and data collection
- Interpersonal skills and the ability to work as a member of a high-performing team
- Ability to work independently
- Analytical and visual graphics skills including strong experience with Excel and/or PowerPoint. Familiarity with either a statistical software package (i.e., STATA, SAS) or video-editing software is a plus.
- Interest in learning about issues relating to compensation and rewards for work
- Preference will be given to those with relevant work experience; all encouraged to apply.
