## Cornell ILR Alumni Association, Membership Committee Analysis of Recent ILRAA Additions January 5, 2012

## Analysis of Additions

The table below summarizes the number of individuals that have purchased ILRAA memberships between 7/1/2011 and 1/3/2012. (Note: some individuals purchased multiple memberships during this time period; for purposes of this analysis they have only been included once.)

## Highlights:

- 66% of the additions are from alumni that are 20 40 years out from graduation.
  - o The 1980's have the most additions.
  - o The 1990's and 1970's have the second most additions.
- Recent alumni have the lowest participation in ILRAA.
- 21.4% of the additions are graduate students (MS/MILR/MPS/PhD).

When comparing to the total population of ILR Alumni, the following points can be made.

- BS and graduate students participate in ILRAA at equal levels (3.7% of both populations are ILRAA members).
- Approximately 2% of recent grads (2009 and 2010) are members of ILRAA compared to 5% of graduates from the 1970s and 1980s.
