Jessica S. Henry is an Associate Professor of Justice Studies at Montclair State University. For nearly a decade, Professor Henry served as a public defender in Manhattan and the Bronx. In 2005, she joined the faculty at Montclair State. She has published numerous articles in the areas of prisoner reentry and severe sentences, as well as on hate crimes.

In 2011, Professor Henry was the recipient of the Dean's Recognition Award for Outstanding Teaching. She also serves on the advisory board of ReLeSe, a prisoner reentry project in Newark, NJ. Professor Henry has appeared as a commentator on national television and has been interviewed by national and local media.
